Jobseekers Programme FAQ's



- 1. How long does the programme run?**
The programme will run for 14 weeks from the start date.
- 2. When is the start date?**
The programme will start the week beginning 17th October 2016 and will finish the week beginning 13th February 2017.
- 3. How many hours/days per week?**
Programme will take place two days per week and a further day placement/ work experience in a school/ sports club or community group from in late October.
- 4. Will the programme involve weekends?**
There may be a need for one or two Saturdays but programme will primarily take place during the week during office hours (9am-5pm)
- 5. What does the programme involve-**
Programme is made up of various introductory level coaching courses as well as modules in Personal Development, CV writing and job seeking skills etc. There will also be a number of hours each week where participants in the programme will be placed in local youth and community groups to gain experience.
- 6. Do you have to be a member of a sports club or play sports?**
No, you do not need to be a member of a sports club, but you need to have an interest in sport and sports coaching.
- 7. Will I get paid?**
No, and your social welfare payment will not be affected.
- 8. Will my fitness levels be tested?**
No, there will be no fitness testing.
- 9. Will I have to organise my own placement experience?**
NO, we will help you with your placement experience. If you are involved in a club we will be encouraging you to get involved with them.
- 10. Is this programme certified?**
This programme is an entry level (level 3) programme and will be certified on the QQI framework. All sport courses undertaken and successfully completed will also be fully certified.
- 11. Will I have to be Garda vetted?**
Yes, all participants will be Garda vetted.
- 12. Will there be follow on courses?**
Progression routes from this programme will be discussed over the duration of the programme. There are many options available to participants who successfully complete this programme.
- 13. Where is the course taking place?**
All courses will run out of the Meath and District league club house in Navan. Some courses may require travel to venues outside of those mentioned but transport will be arranged if this is the case.
